Job Description

This is a hands-on position that requires a mature, responsible and service oriented person to conduct daily, weekly and as needed maintenance services, repairs and janitorial duties.

Location and Shifts

- Work would be at the Sqemel Lalem (Pithouse Lodge) near Hope, BC.
- Shift are typically on a 20 and 10 rotation and hours could range from 8-12 per day depending on guest occupancy levels.

Job Qualifications

- Strong mechanical skills and familiar with basic electrical, plumbing, carpentry
- Previous construction or maintenance experience is ideal
- Completion of basic First Aid, WHIMIS, HCCAP (Hazard Analysis Critical Control Points), Travel Restraint, Transport of Dangerous Goods, Accident Investigation, and Health and Safety Training an asset.
- Organization, cleanliness and a professional attitude are a must.
- Attention to detail is important
- Excellent interpersonal, verbal and written communication skills
- Strong decision making and delegation skills
- Experience with Microsoft Office applications such as Outlook, Excel and Word an asset
- Superior organization and time management skills
- Team player able to provide support, motivation and encouragement to others

Responsibilities

- Constant monitoring of all camp systems including (but not limited to) diesel generators, water makers, septic systems, plumbing, kitchen appliances, etc.
- Conducting regular maintenance of generators including oil and filter changes
- Operating water purification system on a daily basis
- Minor electrical, plumbing, and carpentry repairs as needed
- Constant attention to safety around the camp
- Monitoring inventory and ordering supplies as needed
- Maintain communication with supervisor

Physical Requirements

- Stand, walk, stoop, kneel, or crouch for long periods of time
- Repeat the same movements including, reparative movements of hands and wrists
- Use muscles to lift, push, pull or carry objects up to 50 lbs
- Reach with hands and arms
- Use hands to handle objects and tools
